Series Logline

"Novi, a spirited preteen girl, is forced to embrace her inner power to rescue her kidnapped friend from the dark forces running the oppressive dystopian society in which she lives. "

Moonpies takes place in Nume, a dystopian society that demands children conform to assigned family career expectations. Families are only allowed to befriend families that share the same gift. If you have any flaw or difference, the people of Nume believe you cannot carry out your family gift. You will be deemed "faulted" and sent to reside in an institution called Atherton. The "faulted" children who forever disappear are known as "the gone," and nobody is to mention them again...BUT three girls with different family gifts form a secret group called Moonpies and pave the way to a new life in Nume.




Clovi Carie's sweet, pleaser personality and paranoid nature make her an exemplary Numekin. These attributes, combined with her Moonpie devotion, help keep Novi in check in hairy situations. But Clovi's secret is that she is begins to detest her family's sale gift and wants something different. Self-exploration becomes Clovi's theme in life so she can experience the feeling of passion.

Thayer JM Millis is an eccentric soul and provides the Moonpies with endless laughter and memorable moments. Unfortunately, due to her trauma, she has had to hide all her family secrets, even from Clovi and Novi. Her trickiest secret is her DID (Dissociative Identity Disorder.) If her alters become known, she faces rejection from her Moonpies and being separated from her family forever. For Thayer to have inner peace, she must overcome the guilt and shame that control her.

She represents a younger version of Thayer, protecting Thayer from bad trauma memories and handling all her emotions but anger. Thayer has no memory of her and is embarrassed when Shelleigh takes over. However, struggling to feel accepted keeps Shelleigh more present. Neither of them will ever be satisfied until they learn to compromise.




Ramone comes out rarely, only when Thayer is threatened, or provoked. Thayer and Shelleigh despise him because he gets physical and really angry. To keep Ramone in check, Thayer needs to feel safe but Ramone needs to understand his actions are not always helpful.



Muna Mari Millis is Thayer's 10-year-old sister who has become invisible in their household. She is a quiet observer who is anxious and sad due to their family's secrets. Accepting Novi's invitation to become a Moonpie to find Thayer comes at the cost of having to share their family secrets. The journey unexpectedly provides Muna with a support system empowering her to heal.

Francis Kimpy is a goofy chocolate-loving classmate of Novi's. Nobody takes him seriously, even Francis himself. An opportunity to help Novi forces Francis to expose his mom's participation in the underground. Francis follows his heart for the greater good, allowing him to gain the inner confidence he never had.



Orla Sorelle comes across as an arrogant soul with an attitude that keeps the institution kids at a distance. However, loneliness, curiosity, and despair about her identity allow her to open up to Novi. Casting her fears of rejection aside and giving the kids a chance allows Orla to experience acceptance. Finally, Orlo can feel free to live as a HE!







The Moonpie Spot



They managed to hang out again at their secret spot on the lake and not get caught. Knowing how dangerous it is for them to be friends keeps them on their tippy toes. Making sure the coast is clear, they go home with a plan to meet up tomorrow.

The following day while waiting for the bus, Novi slips Clovi a Moonpie note and she stuffs it in her pocket. But then, the mood changes to serious as all eyes go to the infamous black car barrelling down the street. Everyone knows in Nume, the black car means another child has been deemed "faulted," and one family's life is about to change forever.

On the bus, Novi observes the other children sharing the same curious, worried vibes. The bus continues down their street slowing down as it passes the same black car. Everyone's heads turn out the window. Novi witnesses Thayer being carried out of her house by a Lork, kicking and screaming with her little sister Muna trying to save her. The tears of disbelief and confusion begin roll down Novi's face. Emotions Novi must hide not to give away her secret friendship with Thayer, who has a different family gift.

Throughout the day, Novi refuses to accept that Thayer is one of "the gone." Meanwhile, with Principal Finster distracted, Novi sneaks into his office and steals Thayer's file. An impulse steal that leaves her stressing the rest of the day because she knows how much trouble she and her family would get into if caught.

After school, Novi and Clovi arrive at the Moonpie Spot and place flowers on the empty log where Thayer should be. Clovi gazes at Novi empathetically. She wipes a tear and puts her arm around Novi. Both agree they must find Thayer. Clovi looks at Novi's face, "What...tell me." Novi slowly pulls the file out of her backpack. After Clovi finishes her paranoid meltdown, she makes Novi promise never to read the file and get rid of it ASAP.

Novi shifts to her other idea to invite Thayer's sister Muna to be an honorary Moonpie member hoping Muna could provide important clues. Shockingly, Clovi gives a thumbs up, approving "Mission Muna." Excited yet incredibly anxious, they sneak off to Muna's house. Fortunately, their risky adventure ends with a celebration once back at the Moonpie Spot. Even though they can't tell anybody how they dodged the nosey neighbor and had an encounter with Novi's brother, it makes for a good story they hope to share with Thayer soon.

That night Novi locks her bedroom door and walks back to her bed, focused and intense. She grabs Thayer's file, and a tear rolls down her face. Then, all goes dark as she puts a blanket over her head. A click is heard as she turns her flashlight on, and with hesitation, she opens the file. Novi is now a full-blown one-of-a-kind like never seen before Nume Breaker (person who goes against Nume's rules). There is no turning back. #FreeTHAYER

Novi's parents have instilled in her that Nume comes first, but her secret best friend is taken, creating an internal struggle. However, her heart wins, and her desire for justice takes over. This inspires her to rally others to help in her plight. Novi knows the first step is to find the institution where Nume sends "the faulted." Yet staying under the radar is difficult with Principal Finster, the nosey neighbor Nessie, Nupes, and The Lorks. Evading being caught allows the Moonpies to discover The Nameless City where the institution, Atherton is. Now they must figure out how to get Thayer out. Novi jumps into save mode wanting to bust Thayer right out of Atherton. But, her lack of patience becomes detrimental as what seems like the perfect escape plan goes awry. Atherton officials have been tipped off! The officials sound the alarm.

The Moonpies realize they need help. Novi turns to her parents, believing they will assist, yet they try to stop her efforts. This creates confusion and disappointment, forcing her to enlist the underground. The Moonpies gather more clues on the underground before making contact. Finally, a solid far-fetched plan pays off, and Thayer is back in the Nume hood down the street from Novi, where she belongs. A first of its kind release and all thanks to the Moonpies. Big phew, Thayer is safe, and the long-awaited Moonpie meeting can commence. But the secret celebration comes to a halt when a Nupe discovers the Moonpie spot and threatens to expose them all!

Novi identifies as a Nume Breaker, which makes her forge ahead to keep the Moonpies together. Thayer takes time to adjust back into the Nume groove. She cautiously shares her alters with them. Still fired up with seeking justice, Novi encourages the Moonpies that their next mission is to solve the mystery of the family that disappeared. This becomes an obsession, yet Clovi wants to avoid partaking in the rabbit hole adventure. Both are unwilling to compromise, resulting in their first official fight putting a divide in the Moonpies. In an attempt to encourage others to rise up, Novi makes quite the scene at the school art show. Unfortunately, her dissent backfires, and she is deemed "faulted." When the Lorks come to take her away, she pauses to see if her parents will fight for her, but they don't. Looking at her parents, she storms out of the house and walks down to the black car. Instead of getting in, she picks her bike up, hops on, and takes off. Novi knows what it is like to feel like the black sheep of Nume and owns every bit. A pursuit ensues by the Lorks to capture Novi, but she refuses to turn herself in. Novi refuses to become one of "the gone."
